What is SETTT for Success?

Special Educator Technology-Based Training of Trainers (SETTT) for Success is a US Department of Education funded project that supports online professional learning for teacher trainers as they design and deliver quality professional development for teachers of students with the most significant cognitive disabilities. The SETTT for Success project will include a dashboard with resources to support trainers' design of effective professional development (PD), including a PD framework that supports trainer learning through curated online resources, trainer learning modules, online coaching, and a virtual community of practice. SETTT for Success maintains a specific focus on improving professional development for teachers who provide academic instruction for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities.
